Commander Willie D. Brisbane is the commander of 10th Battalion, United States Military Entrance Processing Command and the Jacksonville Military Entrance Processing Station.

She enlisted in the Navy at the Memphis Military Entrance Processing Station in March 1990. Her enlisted assignments include a tour aboard the submarine tender USS L. Y. Spear, homeported in Norfolk, Virginia; and yeoman, Chief of Naval Operations, Washington, District of Columbia. She received her commission through the Enlisted Commissioning Program in 1999. Following this, her assignments include administrative officer/auxiliaries-electrical officer aboard the Ticonderoga-class cruiser USS Yorktown, homeported in Pascagoula, Mississippi; auxiliary officer aboard the Tarawa-class amphibious assault ship USS Peleliu, homeported in San Diego, California; action officer, Navy Personnel Command, Millington, Tennessee; enlisted programs officer/operations officer, Navy Recruiting District Jacksonville, Florida; reserve support officer/manpower officer, Navy Operational Support Center, Jacksonville; officer programs officer, Navy Recruiting Region West, Millington; and promotion board sponsor, Navy Personnel Command, Millington.
