He served as personnel actions center clerk, 302nd Forward Support Battalion, Camp Casey, Republic of Korea; personnel system clerk, Standard Installation And Division, Center Military Police, Fort Bliss, Texas; human resource sergeant, Yuma Health Clinic, Yuma Proving Grounds, Arizona; detail recruiter, El Paso Company, Phoenix Recruiting Battalion; human resources sergeant, 1st Battalion, 77th Armor, 1st Infantry Division, Schweinfurt, Germany, deployed to Iraq as human resource sergeant and military transition team advisor to the Iraqi Army; Small Group Leader, Advanced Leader And Senior Leader Course, Noncommissioned Officer Academy, Fort Jackson, South Carolina, deployed to Joint Task Force Bravo, Soto Cano Air Base, Honduras and served as the joint senior administrative noncommissioned officer; senior human resources sergeant, 39th Transportation Battalion, 21st Theater Sustainment Command, Kaiserslautern, Germany, deployed to Incirlik Air Base, Turkey, and deployed to Afghanistan; and senior human resources sergeant, 2nd Cavalry Regiment, Vilseck, Germany.
