First Sergeant Darryl M. Borne is the senior enlisted advisor of the Honolulu Military Entrance Processing Station.

First Sergeant Borne enlisted in the U.S. Army in November 1988, completing Basic Combat Training at Fort Jackson, S.C., and Advanced Individual Training as a switchboard systems operator specialist at Fort Gordon, Ga. He later reclassified and completed Advanced Individual Training as a personnel information systems management specialist, at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Ind., in 1991. He served in numerous enlisted leadership positions, as a squad leader, section leader, platoon sergeant, detachment sergeant, drill sergeant, senior drill sergeant, advanced leadership course instructor, and senior human resources noncommissioned officer in charge, at the detachment, battalion, brigade and joint levels.
