Senior Master Sergeant Edwin L. Davis is the senior enlisted advisor of the El Paso Military Entrance Processing Station.

Senior Master Sergeant Davis enlisted in the United States Air Force in April 1991 at the El Paso Military Entrance Processing Station. He completed Basic Training at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas, and technical training at Sheppard Air Force Base, Texas. He was first assigned as a utilities systems apprentice in the 49th Civil Engineering Squadron at Holloman Air Force Base, N.M. In July 1994 he retrained in the personnel career field. After completing his technical training at Keesler Air Force Base, Miss., he returned to the 49th Mission Support Squadron at Holloman Air Force Base where he worked as a relocation counselor. In 1998 he was then assigned to the Air Force Personnel Center, Randolph Air Force Base, Texas, where he served as noncommissioned officer-in-charge of the Air Force Selection Board Secretariat and active duty commitments team lead in the Field Operations Branch. In 2004 he was assigned as the noncommissioned officer-in-charge, Commander's Support Staff, 2nd Maintenance Operations Squadron, Barksdale Air Force Base, La. In 2006 he was assigned as the noncommissioned officer-in-charge, Outbound Assignments, 2nd Mission Support Squadron and in 2008 assigned as noncommissioned officer-in-charge, Senior Leader Support, 8th Air Force, Barksdale, La. In 2010 he was assigned to the 321st Air Expeditionary Wing, as personnel programs superintendent in Baghdad, Iraq. After completing his tour in Iraq he returned to Barksdale Air Force Base in 2011 to the 2nd Force Support Squadron as the superintendent, Military Personnel Section and finally as the superintendent, Manpower and Personnel Flight.



His professional military education includes Airman Leadership School, Noncommissioned Officer Academy, Senior Enlisted Joint Professional Military Education Course, and Senior Noncommissioned Officer Academy. He also earned an Associate of Science Degree in Human Resource Management from the Community College of the Air Force, Professional Management Certification from the Community College of the Air Force, Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, Wayland Baptist University, Plainview, Texas, and Master of Science in Business Administration, Webster University.
