First Sergeant Jeremy T. Mullennix is the senior enlisted advisor of the Houston Military Entrance Processing Station.

First Sergeant Mullennix enlisted in the United States Army in October 1996 through the Houston Military Entrance Processing Station. He proceeded to Fort Jackson, SC where he completed Basic Combat Training and Advanced Individual Training. His first duty station was at Fort Polk, Louisiana from 1997 to 1999 where he served with 115th Field Hospital and the U.S. Army Air Ambulance Detachment. He was then assigned to the 702d Main Support Battalion, Camp Casey, Korea from 1999 to 2000.

In July of 2000, he was assigned to 1st Brigade, 3rd Battalion, 66th Armor, 4th Infantry Division, Fort Hood, Texas from 2000 to 2005. While stationed at Fort Hood he was deployed to Iraq from March 2003 to April 2004.

His next assignment was to Fort Bragg, NC, where he served with Headquarters, United States Army Special Operations Command from 2005 to 2015 serving in various positions. During this period he deployed multiple times in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation New Dawn, and Operation Enduring Freedom.

First Sergeant Mullennix' professional military education includes the Warrior Leaders Course, Advanced and Senior Leaders Course, Survival, Evasion, Resistance, and Escape Course, Equal Opportunity Representative Course, Basic Airborne Course, Battle Staff Course, and the Small Group Instructor Course. He has also earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in History from Thomas Edison State College, Trenton, NJ.

First Sergeant Mullennix' awards and decorations include two Bronze Star Medals, two Defense Meritorious Service Medals, the Meritorious Service Medal, the Joint Service Commendation Medal, Army Commendation Medal with Valor device, four Army Commendation Medals, the Joint Service Achievement Medal, three Army Achievement Medals, and various unit and service medals and ribbons.
