Lieutenant Commander Les A. Huffman is the commander of the Oklahoma City Military Entrance Processing Station.

Lieutenant Commander Huffman enlisted in the Navy as a Machinist's Mate (Nuclear) in 1997, was selected for Broadened Opportunity for Officer Selection and Training pre-commissioning training in 1998 and received his commission through the Navy Reserve Officers' Training Corps. He served as a division officer, Engineering Department, on the Colorado-class battleship USS West Virginia, homeported in Kings Bay, Georgia; assistant operations officer, Submarine Squadrons 16 and 20, navigation and training support for ballistic missile-type and guided missile-type submarine crews; and current operations officer, Navy Reserve Forces Command, Norfolk, Virginia.
