### Fairchild Air Force Base

Fairchild Air Force Base is comprised of the 92d Air Refueling Wing (host wing), the 141st Air Refueling Wing (Washington Air National Guard), the 336th Training Group (Air Education and Training Command), the Armed Forces Reserve Center, and 15 other tenant organizations. Team Fairchild encompasses 6,000 Air Force active duty, Air National Guard, Army Guard Reserve members, and civilian employees.



The 92 ARW provides air refueling, rapid and reliable passenger and cargo airlift, and aero-medical evacuation missions supporting U.S. and coalition conventional operations as

This capability provides aerial refueling support to Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps and allied nation aircraft. The KC-135 is also capable of transporting litter and ambulatory patients during aeromedical evacuations.
