INSERT B-ROLL	(VO continues)  Each exercise begins with a simulated accident on the Army post, and expands from there as off-post authorities are notified, protective action decisions are made, and simulated warnings and instructions are sent to the public and media.
INSERT B-ROLL	Once the exercise is under way, participants are expected to respond as they would in an actual event. Players don't know the scenario beforehand. The only information they have is based on what is happening in real time.
