# REMINDER: THE FY 2014 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANTS (AFG) APPLICATION PERIOD CLOSES ON FRIDAY, DECEMBER 5, 2014 AT 5:00 P.M. EST

The FY 2014 AFG Grant open application period is underway. We recommend that you start your application today by reviewing the application and organizational requirements below under **Application Assistance Tools**. These tools were produced specifically to help potential applicants begin to plan their 2014 applications ahead of the application period.

### SAM.GOV REGISTRATION REQUIRED TO SUBMIT YOUR FY 2014 AFG APPLICATION

All eligible AFG applicants must be registered and active in the System for Award Management (SAM) **before** an application can be submitted. Per 2 CFR § 25.205, FEMA may not make an award to an entity until the entity has complied with the requirements to provide a valid DUNS number and maintain an active SAM registration with current information.

#### **SAM.gov Registration Tips:**

Please ensure the following items are current in SAM and the DUNS number used in SAM is the same one you use for all FEMA applications:

- Organization's name
- Address
- Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS)
- Employer Identification Number (EIN)
- Banking information (type of account (checking or saving), routing number, and account number

- SAM registration is only active for one year and must be renewed annually.
