- 1. Purpose. Provide a summary of the FY 2017 DON President's Budget.
 - a. Budget Overview.
- The Fiscal Year 2017 (FY17) baseline budget submission for the Department of the Navy (DON) is \$155.4 billion. The DON FY17 budget supports missions specified in Quadrennial Defense Review (QDR), and the priorities of the Secretary of the Navy, Chief of Naval Operations, and Commandant of the Marine Corps.




- Military basic pay and civilian pay are increased by 1.6 percent.
 - Continued OCO-to-Base transfer
 - Battle force ship count is 287 in FY 2017
 - Ship depot maintenance funded to 100 percent in baseline and OCO funding
 - Ship operations funded to support 58 underway days per quarter for deployed forces and 24 days per quarter for non-deployed forces with OCO funding
 - Navy/Marine Corps flying hours budgeted at T-2.0
 - Percentage of required maintenance funded in base and OCO in FY17: Ship Depot: 100%,

Aviation Depot: 85%, Marine Corps ground equipment: 79%. Baseline sustainment of shore facilities is funded at 70% of requirement for Navy and 74% for Marine Corps.




