Residency Questionnaire Recommendations

Eligible TAMS Applicants must validate their Texas residency for admissions to TAMS. The Residency Questionnaire (RQ) is intended for students entering college after HS graduation. This leads to confusion as TAMS applicants complete the form. Please take close note of the recommendations to complete the questionnaire correctly.

- 1. During the 12 months prior to the term for which you are applying, did you attend a public college or university in Texas in a fall or spring term?
 - 'Yes' if the student has been enrolled in <u>college level courses at a public</u>
 <u>college or university in Texas</u>. Dual Credit courses can apply, but require verification of enrollment by the school. This can delay determination.
