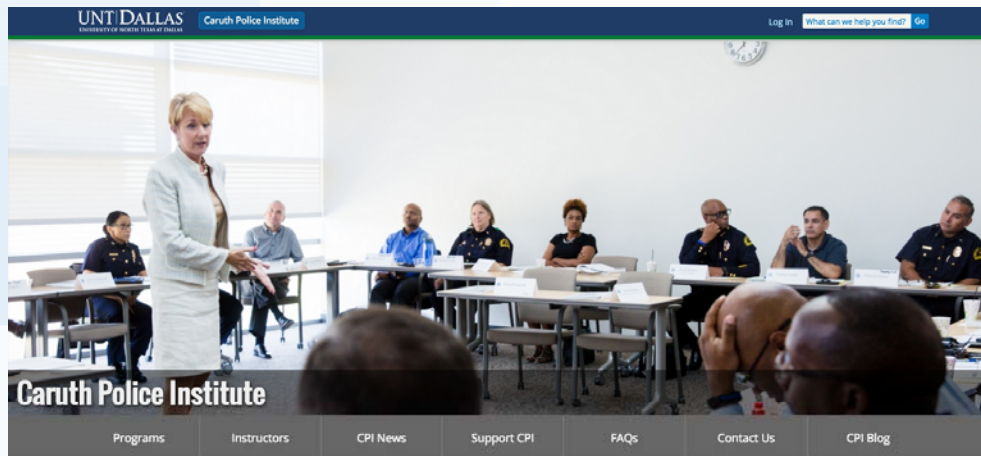

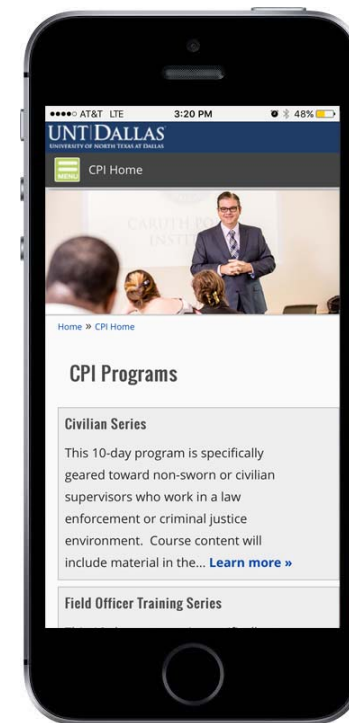

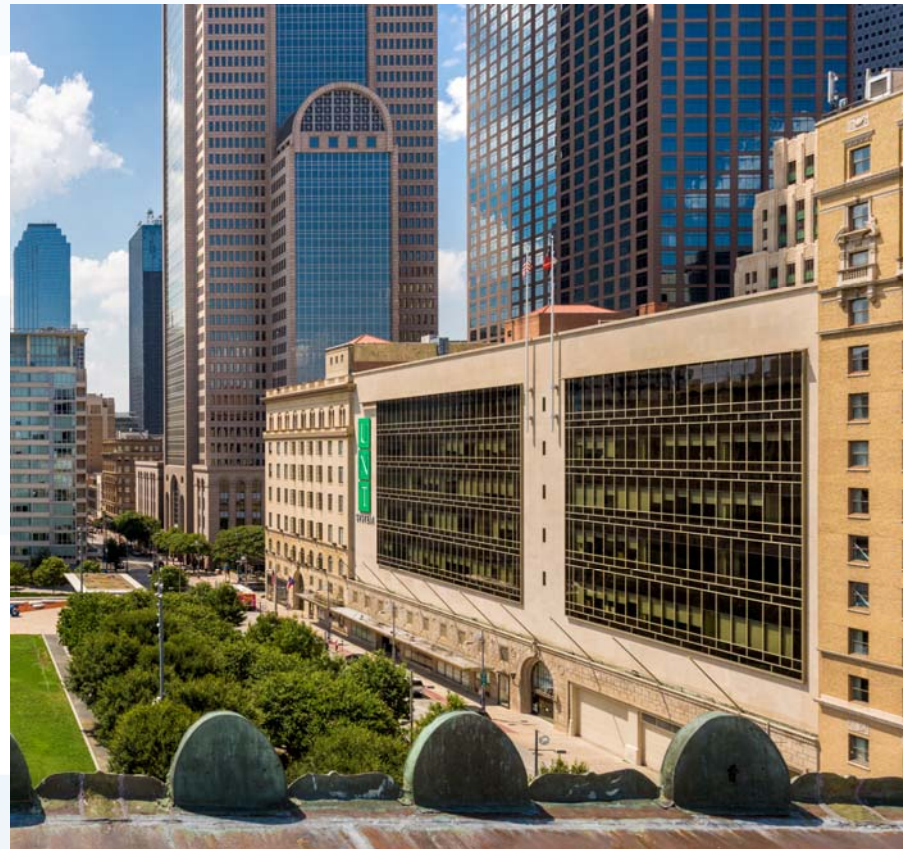

- Regent's approved our FY 17 budget

- Revenue sources totaled \$40.3 million

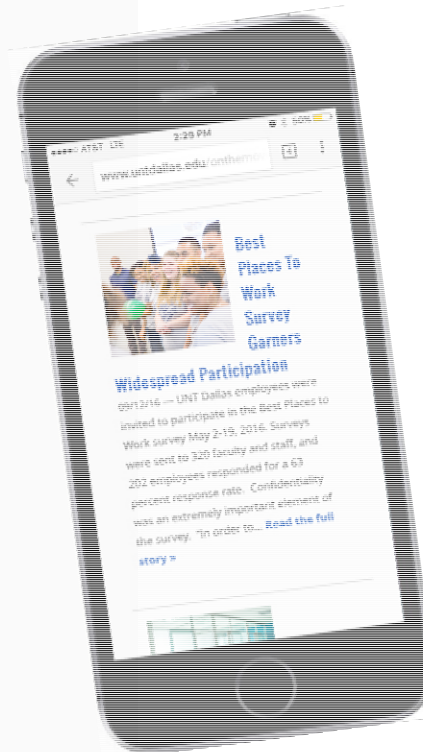


Renovations to Increase Efficiencies
