- Business International Content Area:
 - 12 hrs from International Business Content Area (see advisor for approved list)
- Business Content Area 2:
 - 12 hours from any approved Business Content Area list (see advisor for approved lists)
- **6 hours** of Business Integrated Studies Electives (3/4000 level Business courses (approved by advisor).
- Additional Requirements to be completed within the above 30 hrs.
 - Must encompass a total of at least three business subject areas
 - 3 hours must be completed from the Creation of Goods and Services requirement (DSCI 3870, LSCM 3960, OPSM/MGMT 3830, ECON 4140 or other approved Creation of Goods and Services courses)
 - * At least 15 hours must be completed at the 4000 level
- Other requirements
 - * Students must provide proficiency in a foreign language through the level of 2050
 - Completion of a study abroad/international experience

*Important: there are restrictions and limitations regarding how Business Content Areas can be combined and courses selected. The following restrictions apply:

- if two content areas contain the same course, that course may only be used for one content area (no double-dipping of courses between Business Subject Areas)
- there are no substitutions to the courses listed in the content areas

College of Business graduation requirements:

- A grade of C or higher is required in all Business foundation, and Professional Field and Supporting Field courses.
- A 2.0 UNT, 2.0 Overall, and 2.0 Professional/Supporting Field GPA is required for graduation.

- Completion of all pre-business prerequisite courses and a UNT cumulative 2.7 minimum gpa are required prior to enrolling in any jr./sr. level business courses and/or filing for an official degree plan.
- A total of 120 credit hours are required for this degree. GPA requirements for graduation: 2.0 UNT cumulative, 2.7 Professional Field, and 2.0 Overall.

^{**} Courses that will fulfill university core and pre-business requirements. Courses used to fulfill both University and College requirements will increase number of required free electives to reach 120 hours minimum for graduation. Consult your advisor for questions on number of free electives needed.
