<b>07.026 Health Insurance for International Students</b>	<b>Student Affairs</b>

**Policy Statement.** All international students and scholars holding non-immigrant visas must carry UNT-approved health insurance coverage during the entire period of their UNT residence.

**Application of Policy.** International Students.

**Definitions.**

1. **Residence.** Residence is defined as that continuous period from initial orientation and enrollment or employment, including holidays, through graduation or final separation from the university.

**Procedures and Responsibilities.**

International students are automatically charged for the UNT-offered policy each semester at registration, and must provide proof of comparable insurance by the established deadline at International Advising to avoid purchasing the UNT-offered policy. International scholars must demonstrate acceptable insurance coverage at International Advising during their initial orientation session.
