## HISTORY OF SCHOLARSHIP

In 1993, Rose Crawford was an integral component of a well-run association, serving as the MLS trainer. Rose always went above and beyond in all her duties. Rose's son, Josh Stoner, was a high school athlete and scholar, with a single mother struggling to make ends meet. Although they were both excited about the idea of college for Josh, they deemed it out of reach.

The GDWCAR Members rallied and with lobbying efforts from some very determined GDWCAR members Josh was accepted to Centenary. Everything he needed for dorm life was given by the membership. Bake sales and auctions were organized and held at association meetings. When a plea for funds for room and board went out at the beginning of each semester, cash poured in.

Tragedy struck. Rose died unexpectedly and Josh was left without his mom and biggest supporter. He was a junior at Centenary, team trainer and outstanding student.

Our association came together to form *The Rose Crawford Memorial Scholarship Fund* and with the support of Centenary coaches, administration and GDWCAR, Josh Stoner earned his degree.

### **GUIDELINES & POLICIES**

- 2. The Scholarship Sub Committee for GDWCAR shall meet in February to review and select recipients.
- 3. The application is two (2) pages and must be submitted in its entirety. Do not change or retype this form as this will disqualify application. Complete every section using "NA" for items that are not applicable.
- 4. Submission package must have the following items in this order:
  - a. Application Requirement Checklist (as the top form to submission package)
  - b. Application for Scholarship Consideration (fully completed)
  - c. Reference Letters (3 required)
    - i. Require a printed name, company name, title, phone #, email and signature.
  - d. Documentation to support eligibility including an "official transcript".
- 5. THE GDWCAR Scholarship amounts vary from year to year based on donations and need.
- 6. Scholarship recipients shall be notified by written letter in February and asked to attend the March Education Luncheon for GDWCAR, the first Thursday, for a presentation ceremony.
- 7. Applicant acknowledges that scholarships are paid directly to the institution of acceptance, upon confirmation, supplied by and through institution, on official institution letterhead.
- 8. If selected as a finalist, a personal interview could be scheduled with applicant at a date TBD. Interviews will be held at GDWCAR.
- 9. Applicant is eligible for only one scholarship per year.
- 10. Applicant must be pursuing an education in the real estate industry.
