1. **Hours Required and General/College Requirements:** A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree with a GPA of a 2.0 or higher
2. **Specialization/Certificate Program Requirements:** A minimum of 12 hours in one of the approved human services specialization or certificate programs.
3. **Recommended Electives:** DFST 1013D, DFST 2033D, SOCI 2070D, SOWK 3500D, SOWK 4540D
4. **Core Competencies:** The HSML degree requires students to demonstrate competence in seventeen (17) professional areas. Some of these competencies may be covered by a single course; some may be covered by several required activities such as service learning projects, participating in student organization events, or the internship.
