The Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences (BAAS) degree will allow students the opportunity to combine completed coursework from a community college or the military with University of North Texas at Dallas (UNT Dallas) courses to create a unique degree with concentrations and an occupational specialization. Students will find this degree attractive because it allows them to create an interdisciplinary approach to their study at UNT Dallas. The program requirements are for El Centro College students who wish to transfer to UNT Dallas under the agreed upon terms set for in the articulation agreement between El Centro College (ECC) and UNT Dallas for the academic program of Interior Design.

**Requirement 1:** The BAAS degree is a 125 semester hour academic program, of which 42 must be advanced and 30 must be taken at UNT D.

**Requirement 2:** 9 hours of Professional Foundation core requirement including: *(Must earn a grade of C or better)*  
 HSML 3000 – Human Service in the Nonprofit Sector (or an upper level substitution from one of the concentration area with prior Dean approval)  
 SOCI 3220 – Quantitative Data Collection  
 SOCI 4540 – Race and Ethnic Minorities

**Requirement 3:** 36 hours of Professional Development. Student must complete one primary and one secondary interdisciplinary concentration.
