•UNT - The average annual cost of attendance for a Texas resident living
•on campus and enrolled in 15 hours per semester is \$22,826.
•UNT - just tuition = \$5,045.00/s 10,0090/y
•National as of 2012-2013 = 17,474/y
•On campus housing/food/etc. cost = \$11,892/y
•COA breakdown - services provided, etc.
•FAFSA

Example:

\$4,900 Fall refund or income

\$3,335 Fall semester expenses

\$1,565

Emergencies, gas, food, late payments, parking tickets..... \$1,565/ 4.5 months=

\$348 a month/ 4weeks=


