Head Coach

Fourth Year ▶ Crown College '91

Head coach Andrew Palileo (paw-leh-lay-oh) continues to

develop what has been a young and exciting North Texas volleyball team.

Palileo's third year was another one of success as the Mean Green recorded its second 20-win season in three years under the Hawaii native.

Senior Carnae Dillard was a showcase of the 2015-16 season, and under Palileo's leadership she repeated as Conference USA Player of the Year before becoming only the second honorable mention All-American selection in team history.

North Texas advanced to the semifinal round of the C-USA Tournament behind a .241 hitting percentage that was the second-best mark in school history. Also joining Dillard with all-conference honors was Holly Milam, who earned a spot on the All-C-USA second team.

In his second year at the helm, Palileo guided the Mean Green to one of the best seasons in school history. Led by Conference USA Player of the Year Carnae Dillard, Palileo & Co. racked up a 21-9 record entering the postseason, the second-best regular season win total in North Texas history.

With momentum on its side and riding a program-best 10-match win streak, North Texas would make it to the C-USA semifinal round before falling to eventual conference champion WKU. The team's individual talent was recognized as Dillard took all-conference first team honors, senior Hanna Forst was named to the second team, and Amanda Chamberlain was placed on the conference's all-freshman squad.

In his first year at North Texas, Palileo guided the Mean Green through its initial year in C-USA and accumulated a 17-15 record that came within a few points of the conference's semifinal round. Two players, sophomore Carnae Dillard and senior Karissa Flack, were named to the C-USA all-conference team while setter Amy Henard was named to the all-freshman squad.

He arrived in Denton for his first season from Ohio State where he was an assistant coach for two years,

bringing an extensive resume of experience at the Big-10 and Pac-12 levels to the Mean Green. His most recent head coaching position was at Washington State from 2008-2010. While in Pullman, Wash., Palileo took the Cougars to the NCAA tournament in 2009, their first trip in seven years. He also received the Pac-12 Coach of the Year award that same season.

Before heading to Washington State, Palileo was a head coach for seven years at South Dakota State where he gathered 154 wins and 86 losses. He was named the 2007 Summit League Coach of the Year when the South Dakota State Jacks were the Summit League regular season and tournament champions and made the first trip in school history to the NCAA Championship Tournament. Palileo's crew broke or tied 23 team or individual records during 2007.

Prior to South Dakota State, Palileo was the head volleyball coach at Bethel University (St. Paul, Minn.), where he had an 84-51 record in four seasons, the best four-year mark in school history. While at Bethel, he produced eight first-team all-conference players, a first-team All-American and two academic All-Americans.

Palileo also coached the Club SoDa 18s volleyball team in Brookings, S.D., from 2002-2008, and was the Heartland Adidas Select Volleyball Program 18s head coach for five years in Minneapolis, Minn.

He served as the director of the Crosstown Junior Olympics at Edina High (Minn.) from 1993-97, and he was the JV coach at Waconia (Minn.) High from 1986-90.

A highly-regarded clinician, Palileo has also been the head coach of the Midwest Volleyball Instructor Elite Camps since 1997.

A graduate of Crown College (St. Bonifacius, Minn.), Palileo received his bachelor of arts degree in missiology in 1991 and a bachelor of arts degree in social science/secondary education in 1995. He went on to earn a master's degree in educational leadership from Bethel University (St. Paul, Minn.) in 2000.

Palileo and his wife, Wendy, have three sons - Ashton, Austin and A.J. - while their daughter, Alyvia, is on this year's roster.

Vinh Nguyen

Assoc. Head Coach

Second Year ▶ Cal Poly Pomona '00

Vinh Nguyen enters his second season as an assistant coach on the North Texas staff.

The coaching veteran plays an integral role in all aspects of Mean Green volleyball, special-

izing in the training of the middle and pin hitters, arm swing development and offensive/defensive blocking systems.

A Mission Viejo, Calif., native, Nguyen brings an extensive resume of longevity and success to Denton. He joined the coaching staff after a year of volunteering nationwide.

In the fall of 2014, Nguyen did a stint of assistant coaching at Golden West College in Huntington Beach before volunteering for the Mean Green during the second half of the 2014 season and into the conference tournament. He was with the team for wins over Rice, TCU, UTSA and Southern Miss.

Before 2014, Nguyen spent time at Cal State Fullerton, where he reinvigorated the Titans' offensive attack. In his six seasons with the school, CSUF hitters earned a total of two Big West Player of the Year awards and three AVCA All-American honors.

Nguyen's expertise translated to team success as well. In 2010, the Titans won the Big West Conference and advanced to the NCAA tournament for the first time in school history. The Titans recorded a school-record .246 team hitting percentage on the year while leading the BWC in kills per set (14.45).

For 12 seasons before his time at Fullerton, Nguyen was an assistant coach at Cal Poly Pomona where he helped head coach Rosie Wegrich lift the Broncos to six seasons with at least 18 wins, including a program-best 24-3 mark in 2005. That same year, Pomona won the California Collegiate Athletic Association championship, its first since 1990.

In the summer of 2009, Nguyen was named the administrator to the Southern California High Performance teams that participated at the USA Championships in Ft. Lauderdale, Fla. He oversaw the four SCVA HP teams in Ft. Lauderdale and as a result, the SCVA Select Red team earned a gold medal at the HP Championships.

In 2007, Nguyen was hired by the USA Men's National Team as a staff member to help them prepare for their run at World League, Pan-Am Cup, Americas Cup and Norceca Cup championships, which resulted in two gold medals, a silver and a bronze.

Nguyen has also been involved with the USA High Performance Pipeline since 2003, and he continues to coach at developmental camps throughout the United States. Nguyen also coached at five Southern California high schools (Hoover, San Gabriel, Arcadia, Alhambra and La Habra) and worked with the San Gabriel, Magnum and Power Volleyball Clubs.

In 1996, Nguyen co-founded the Top Gun Volleyball Club, one of Southern California's most respected youth volleyball programs that has trained more than 1500 athletes since its inception. Even after nearly two decades, he continues to coach youth teams throughout the club season.

Nguyen played volleyball at Mt. San Antonio College and Long Beach City College before transferring into the Big West Conference with Long Beach State. He finished his schooling and graduated from Cal Poly Pomona in 2000 with a degree in kinesiology.



Kaylee Fifer

Assistant Coach

First Year ▶ Colgate '13

Kaylee Fifer enters her first season as an assistant coach with the North Texas volleyball team and joins the Mean Green after serving as a graduate assistant at TCU.

Fifer handled a variety of roles during her time with the Horned Frogs and was on staff when TCU qualified for the NCAA Tournament this past season. In her GA role, Fifer was primarily in charge of compiling statistical analytics, handling video during practices and games, and coaching at camps and clinics throughout the year.

As a player, Fifer saw action in every match of her college career and was a consistent starter at setter for Colgate University. A three-time All-Patriot League selection, Fifer notched two of the top-10 assist seasons in team history, and her 3,645 career assists is still good for second all-time.

Fifer graduated from Colgate in 2013 with a degree in history, and she received her master's degree in liberal arts from TCU in May. A Lantana native, Fifer attended Denton ISD's Guyer High School.

↳ The Beginning Years

1976

The UNT volleyball team posted an 18-11-1 record in its first season as a varsity sport and recorded wins over opponents such as Rice, Baylor and Texas A&M.

1977

In just the second year of the programs existence, the Lady Eagles tallied 26 wins, the most ever for UNT over the course of a single season.

1978

Dolores Copeland led UNT to a 15-19-1 record in her final season as the Lady Eagles coach. The 1978 team defeated the likes of Texas Tech, Kansas, Tulane, Cincinnati, Nebraska and Florida State.

↳ The Guy Era

1979

Vickie Guy began her six year tenure as UNT's head coach. The Lady Eagles went 15-24, winning five games in a row during mid-season. The team defeated Kansas State for the only time in the schools history.

1980

UNT began the new decade with eight straight losses and would see itself repeat its misfortune later in the season with eight more in a row. However, the Lady Eagles overcame the poor streaks to win 17 matches on the season.

1981

The season marked UNT's sixth consecutive 15-plus win season, but still saw the Lady Eagles drop 29 matches. The season wasn't without its high points as this team defeated Baylor three times and Oklahoma twice.

↳ The Southland Conference

1982

With a 10-11 record, the '82 season saw the Lady Eagles come up just one game short of breaking .500 for the first time since 1977. UNT defeated Baylor for the sixth consecutive time and Oklahoma for the fourth time in a row.

1983

UNT's first season as a member of the Southland Conference was a success as it achieved its third winning season in the programs history so far with a 17-14 record. UNT posted its most kills (1,208), attacks (3,577), attack percentage (.167), service aces (268), block solos (73), block assist (247) and block totals (196.5) up to that point. The 268 aces still stands as the record for a single season at UNT.

1984

UNT suffered through its worst season since the

programs beginning, winning only six matches, but still managed a 5-4 record in the Southland Conference.

1985

Former UNT player Dee Edwards was named the new coach at UNT. However, the first of her two seasons as the Lady Eagles coach was a rocky one, winning only five matches and losing her first 11 matches at the helm.

1986

UNT repeated its 5-26 record from 1985. However, the team did record the best hitting percentage ever for a single game with a .442 performance against Grambling in November.

1987

The year saw UNT post one of the biggest turnarounds in school history, more than tripling its win total from '86 with 16. New head coach Carol Pierce led the Lady Eagles to 16-20 record. The team tallied 431 block assists, the most in school history.

1988

The Lady Eagles went 9-18 overall and 2-5 in the Southland Conference. With a school record 119 block solos and 229 total blocks, Kim Martin led the Lady Eagles to a UNT record 454 block solos and 454 total blocks.

1989

Melissa Evans took over the reigns as head coach and highlighted her first season with a win over Tulsa. However, UNT only managed seven wins to 19 losses.

1990

UNT volleyball entered its third decade of existence with a 6-20 record. The Lady Eagles posted the schools third-best hitting percentage all-time at .197.

↳ The Martin Era

1991

Donna Martin was named the new head coach and would go on to lead UNT volleyball through the remainder of the 90's. UNT went 4-21 and struggled to an 0-9 record in the Southland Conference.

1992

Martin and the Lady Eagles improved their win total by five games, going 9-18 on the season and took three games in Southland Conference play.

1993

UNT continued to improve in the Southland Conference, bettering itself over 1992 by one win. The team posted the third most attacks ever at UNT in a single match with 230 against McNeese State in October.

1994

With 13 wins, the '94 season saw UNT reach double-digit victories for the first time since 1987 and almost reach a winning season in the Southland Conference with a 6-7 mark. The Lady Eagles notched 1,513 kills and 1,263 assists, both of which stand second all-time at UNT. They also posted the second-best attack percentage ever at UNT with a .222 mark. Carly Collins hit .344 for the individual school record.

1995

Michelle Dressel and Kim Coffey would lead UNT to the Southland Conference championship and its only appearance ever at the NCAA Tournament. The Lady Eagles went 24-10 and took the conference title with a 14-4 record. The team set school records for kills (1,873), attacks (4,782), attack percentage (.245), assists (1,535) and digs (1,799). Dressel set the standard for single-season assists (1,388) while Coffey did the same for kills (569) and total attacks (1,475).

↳ The Big West

1996

Just one year removed from the Southland Conference championship, the UNT volleyball team made the jump to Division I and joined the powerhouse Big West Conference. Despite the move, the Lady Eagles still managed to win four conference matches and qualify for the Big West Tournament. LaKeta Graham would be UNT's only all-conference player during UNT's four-year stint in the Big West.

1997

In its second year as a member of the Big West, UNT went 6-25 overall and won only one match in the Big West. UNT's season was highlighted by its first win over Rice since 1976 and Tulsa since 1989.

1998

UNT recorded its fewest wins in school history with three and was shutout in the Big West Conference.

1999

Jessica Brown would leave her mark on UNT volleyball, finishing her last season as the schools all-time kill (1,002), total attacks (2,767), and digs (874) leader. In '99 she posted the second-most kills in school history with 405 and had 29 in one match, which is the fifth best mark at UNT for a single match. Despite Brown's efforts and a 3-1 start to the season, the team would only win five matches on the season and record a single victory in Big West play.

↳ The Headrick Era

2000

Cassie Headrick led Mean Green volleyball into the Sun Belt Conference and new decade as the head coach. North Texas posted a 9-20 record overall and won two matches in its new league. This team set a school record for most assists in a single match with 81 against Denver on Nov. 12 and had 1,228 assists for the entire season, third most in school history. Corina Marginas was named Sun Belt Conference Freshman of the Year.

2001

North Texas, which was one point away from defeating Sun Belt Conference champion Florida International in the league tournament, enjoyed its best season since 1995 and had one of the biggest turnarounds in the Sun Belt Conference. The Mean Green finished the regular season 7-8 in conference play and 12-17 overall. The team won its first-ever road game in the Sun Belt and swept two different league foes. North Texas played a school-record 16 five-game matches, including nine of its first 11 outings and dropped nine matches by five points



or less. Corina Marginas earned first-team all-conference honors as she took over the school-record for kills in a career (1,050) as just a sophomore. Kristin Sheppard was named the Sun Belt Conference Newcomer of the Year.

2002

The Mean Green piled up 16 victories, the most since winning 24 matches in 1995. North Texas also went 10-5 in Sun Belt Conference action, giving the team its most victories in its three-year history as a member of the league. The 2001 team broke the school record for kills in a season with 1,932 and also won a school-record eight consecutive matches. Corina Marginas was named a unanimous selection to the All-Sun Belt First Team for the third straight season and Kristin Sheppard earned second-team All-Sun Belt honors.

2003

The program continued its improvement under Head Coach Cassie Headrick, actually having a breakout year with 22 wins. Those 22 wins marked the first time since 1995 the Mean Green won 20 or more matches and just the third time in school history it eclipsed 20 wins. NT posted its best record in four years as a member of the Sun Belt Conference with a league record of 11-4, which was good enough for a second place finish in the West Division for the second consecutive season. The Mean Green set the school record for kills, attacks, assists and digs and Corina Marginas concluded her career as the programs first All-America player.

2004

The 2004 season was a rebuilding year for the North Texas as it won seven matches, but as its younger players gained more experience the team started to come together. Six of its seven victories came in Sun Belt play and it gave league champion New Mexico State all it wanted in the first round of the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The Mean Green fell 3-1 to the Aggies, but won the first game convincingly and dropped two games by just two points. North Texas had several freshman step up, but possibly none more than Jessica Hulsebosch, who had the best defensive year ever by a Mean Green freshman. She finished the season with 416 digs and tied the school record for digs in a match with 33. Brittney Gregory went over 1,000 kills for her career, making her just the second player in school history to accomplish the feat, and the team finished the season with 1,439 kills for the sixth most in NT history. Gregory was named Second Team All-Sun Belt Conference for her performance.

2005

North Texas finished second in the Sun Belt Conference's West Division, marking the third time in the last four years it has done so. The Mean Green narrowly missed the division championship in 2005, finishing just half a match behind Denver in the standings. NT finished the regular season with a 7-1 record against SBC West opponents, recording at least one win against every team. North Texas finished 2005 by winning five of its final six matches of the season. Catherine Coffey finished her freshman campaign with 135 total blocks, the third most in school history for a single season and the most ever by a North Texas freshman. Sophomore Katy Prokof was

named second-team All Sun Belt after finishing tied for seventh in the Sun Belt in kills for league matches only (3.81 per game).

2006

After entering the 2006 campaign with lofty expectations and a new facility to boot, the Mean Green turned out a historic season in claiming the Sun Belt Conference's Western Division crown for the first time. North Texas had to defeat Denver in the final match of the season for a share of the title, but when New Orleans fell on the regular season's final day it left the Mean Green all alone at the top. North Texas had the privilege of hosting the Sun Belt Conference Tournament and the Mean Green took advantage by knocking off New Orleans in the tournament's opening round; however, North Texas ran into the eventual tournament champion Middle Tennessee Blue Raiders in the semifinals and concluded the season with 23 wins. The squad put a number of bullet points next to the season including head coach Cassie Headrick becoming the school's all-time winningest coach. Brooke Engel became the first Mean Green player to lead the nation in a major statistical category when she paced the country in aces with 123, shattering the school record. Catherine Coffey earned her first all-conference honors, and Jessica Hulsebosch destroyed the North Texas defensive record book by setting digs records for single match, season, and career.

2007

The Mean Green rewrote the record books in 2007 with a host of individual accomplishments. Brooke Engel once again led the nation in service aces, becoming the first player in NCAA history to win back-to-back service ace titles. She leaves the program with the two best serving seasons in school history, as well as the career and single match ace records. Jessica Hulsebosch was nearly as accomplished at libero. The four-year starter has nearly 1,000 more digs than any other player in school history, and also owns the single match and season records. Katy Prokof finished her career second in NT history in both kills and attacks. The Mean Green finished the year 12-21 overall in a tie for fourth in the Sun Belt West division.

2008

A young North Texas squad found itself in a rebuilding year in 2008. The Mean Green took to the court with just four returners and 10 newcomers, which was the program's largest incoming class since 1981. Veterans Roxana Casvean and Amy Huddleston paved the way for the offense with 303 and 261 kills, respectively, while newcomers Breanne Owens and Sarah Willey provided the defense with 213 and 322 digs each. North Texas played six straight Sun Belt Conference road matches, which are the most consecutive true road matches in school history.

2009

The Mean Green doubled its win total from 2008, but struggled to a 12-21 record and a first-round exit from the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. On the verge of a breakout all season, the Mean Green dropped seven of their 11 matches that went to five sets. Amy Huddleston

once again provided the Mean Green offense with 414 kills, which ranked ninth in program history. Sarah Willey finished eighth in NT history with 387 digs, while Kati Dillard ranked seventh and fifth in school history in assisted blocks and total blocks with 95 and 123, respectively.

↳ The Murczek Era

2010

First-year head coach Ken Murczek didn't waste any time in turning North Texas back into a force in the Sun Belt. The Mean Green won 20 matches for just the fifth time in school history and claimed the program's second Sun Belt West Division title (and first since 2006). NT advanced to the SBC Tournament semifinals for third time since joining the league in 2000, and led the league in attendance with an average of 452 fans per match. The senior night win over Denver drew a school record 697 fans in standing-room-only fashion. Amy Huddleston finished her career with a First-Team All-Sun Belt bid, and ranks fourth in school history in career kills and third in attacks. Kayla Saey was named to the Second-Team All-Sun Belt after leading the league in assists.

2011

With a 17-17 record, North Texas posted back-to-back .500-plus seasons for the first time since 1976-77 - the founding years of the program. Freshman Eboni Godfrey, who led the Mean Green with 3.14 kills per set, earned second-team All-Sun Belt Conference honors. She also became the first NT freshman to earn an All-Sun Belt Tournament nod. NT finished second only to league champion Western Kentucky with an average of 485 fans per home game, which topped the previous year's average. For a second straight year North Texas advanced to the Sun Belt Tournament semifinals after knocking off Arkansas State in the opening round. Sarah Willey rounded out her stellar career in the Mean Green libero jersey, finishing second in school history in career digs.

2012

In what can only be described as one of the finest seasons in school history, the North Texas volleyball team tied the school record for wins at 26, advanced to the Sun Belt Tournament finals for the first time and claimed its second SBC West Division title in three years. The Mean Green had a pair of players, Carnae Dillard and Courtney Windham, earn first-team all-conference selection for the first time in NT history. Dillard, an All-America candidate, is the only Division I player with over 550 kills, 275 digs and 90 blocks. She posted 552 kills in 2012, which are the most by any freshman in the nation and ranks sixth overall. The SBC Freshman of the Year averaged 6.45 kills per set and her 552 kills were the fourth-most by a North Texas player, and the most ever by an NT freshman. Libero Shelby Tamura had a terrific season with 642 digs in 2012, which are second only in NT history to Jessica Hulsebosch for the school-record of 675 digs in 2006.

2013

A new conference home and a new head coach ushered in a brand new era of North Texas volleyball. First-year head coach Andrew Palileo looked to take Conference USA by storm during its inaugural season and set a new bar for the future of the program. Palileo, a former Pac-12 Coach of the Year, led the Mean Green to an 8-6 conference record and 17-15 overall record after leaving Ohio State for the North Texas head coaching job. Several Mean Green athletes were recognized for their performances on the court. Sophomore Carnae Dillard and senior Karissa Flack were named to the all-conference first and second teams, respectively. Freshman setter Amy Hernard was regarded as one of the nation's top setters coming out of Brock High School in Weatherford, Texas. In her first year at North Texas, Hernard made an immediate impact. She started every set, was named C-USA setter of the week on Sept. 23 and was selected for the C-USA All-Freshman team. Senior Courtney Windham was recognized for her efforts off the court, as she was named a C-USA Fall Spirit of Service honoree for her work in the community. After defeating Florida Atlantic in the first round, No. 5 seed North Texas fell to Marshall in the quarterfinals of the C-USA Tournament in Murfreesboro, Tenn.

2014

In his second year at the helm, head coach Andrew Palileo continued to groom a team that had become a legitimate contender for the Conference USA title. The Mean Green would go on to compile a 22-10 overall record and an 11-5 mark in conference play. North Texas' success on the court was due in large part to the play of Carnae Dillard. The junior outside hitter was named C-USA Player of the Year as she finished the season atop the conference leaderboards in total points and kills. Dillard's season notched her third-consecutive first team all-conference honor. Senior Hanna Forst was named to the second team, while Amanda Chamberlain took a place on the C-USA All-Freshmen squad. North Texas would go on to fall to eventual champion Western Kentucky in the conference tournament's semifinal round.

2015

Palileo's third year was another one of success as the Mean Green recorded its second 20-win season in three years under the Hawaii native. Senior Carnae Dillard was a showcase of the 2015-16 season, and under Palileo's leadership she repeated as Conference USA Player of the Year before becoming only the second honorable mention All-American selection in team history. North Texas advanced to the semifinal round of the C-USA Tournament behind a .241 hitting percentage that was the second-best mark in school history. Also joining Dillard with all-conference honors was Holly Milam, who earned a spot on the All-C-USA second team.
