(1) Describe the purpose of this DoD information system or electronic collection and briefly describe the types of personal information about individuals collected in the system.

The purpose of this system is to track BCNR cases and provide records of the disposition of application for correction of Military records. Files include Military personnel and medical records and evidence supporting allegations of errors and/or injustices. In applicable cases VA records are obtained as well as other information (provided by petitioner-external--and collected by examiner--internal) germane to the petitioner's case.

PII collected includes name, SSN, personal cell telephone number, home telephone number, personal email address, mailing/home address, other: Miltary Records: Present or past pay grade, service number, type of discharge, date of discharge or release from active duty

Other: FAX number; If the record in question is that of a deceased or incompetent person the legal proof of death or incompetency must accompany the application.

Other PII collected is unstructured and consist of free form documents, scanned in as .pdf files (e.g., marriage certificates, job history, any relevant medical information, research performed by BCNR, etc.)

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

PII collected is not released to anyone outside of DOD except those officials connected with the review process and those whom have a valid reason for reviewing case materials (e.g. office of litigation; defending the Board against federal claims and Designated Functional Experts providing Advisory Opinions (AOs) on technical aspects of cases.
ndividuals without involvement in cases are not authorized access to PII materials.
