The purpose of this system is to identify individuals who enroll and take computerized training courses offered through the Navy's Integrated Learning Environment (ILE). Each user will be able to create an individualized training plan, completed Web-based training courses and track their course progress. The system is located at the Naval Education Training Professional Development Technology Center (NETPDTC), Saufley Field, FL 32509-5337. Records are maintained on electronic storage media. Types of PII collected are name, SSN, DOB, pay plan/grade, rank, occupation, UIC, military status. individualized training plan, and course progress. (2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy. Information could be compromised by improper handling, resulting in identity theft. System operators participate in a comprehensive command security program. This program includes annual Information Assurance Awareness training and Privacy Act training. Operators also receive training on using appropriate data handling safeguards. h.
