## How to Access

## the DoJ FOIA Training Modules

- 1. The Department of Justice (DoJ) has made available two training modules on the Freedom of Information (FOIA). Both satisfy the Department of the Navy's annual FOIA training requirement.
- 2. These two course are as follows:
- a. <u>DOJ Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Training for Federal Employees</u>: This is for subject matter experts and other Federal employees who are not FOIA professionals yet, due to the nature of their duties, need familiarization with the FOIA.
  - b. FOIA professionals: this is for professionals engaged in the handling of FOIA requests.
- 3. Both can be accessed via Joint Knowledge Online (JKO) using the following procedures:
  - a. Log into JKO: <a href="http://jko.jfcom.mil/">http://jko.jfcom.mil/</a> (CAC with email certificate works)
  - b. Click on the Course Catalog tab (upper left, below JKO banner)
- c. Click the drop down arrow, just above where it says "Prefix" (it defaults to All), and select DOJ, then click "search."
