Mr. Christopher Page began his present assignment, his first as a Senior Executive, as the Office of Naval Intelligence's (ONI) Command Information Officer in August 2014. In that position, he is responsible for the effective, secure, and efficient execution of Information Technology, Information Management, and Information Assurance operations by ONI for itself, the broader Naval Intelligence community, and that Information Dominance Corps component's global network of naval, joint, interagency, international, and industrial shareholders.

Prior to rejoining ONI in a Defense Intelligence Senior Level capacity, Mr. Page served for more than twenty-six years as an active duty officer in the United States Navy. Commissioned in 1988 at the University of Virginia's (UVA) Naval Reserve Officer Training Corps Unit, he began his service as a Surface Warfare Officer and then became a Special Duty Officer (Intelligence) with an occupational subspecialty in Information Technology Management (ITM). His sea tours included duties as a Midshipman on USS JAMES MADISON (SSBN-627) and USS TRUXTUN (CGN-35), the Combat Information Center/Electronic Warfare Officer on USS Reid (FFG-30), and the Intelligence Officer on USS Peleliu (LHA-5) and USS Ronald Reagan (CVN-76). Shore tours were highlighted by periods of service as the Systems Requirements and Plans Officer for the United States European Command's Joint Analysis Center (JAC) in the United Kingdom, JAC Liaison Officer to the Fifth Allied Tactical Air Force in Italy, Collection Management Mission Applications Project Manager within ONI's Joint Deployable Intelligence Support Systems (JDISS) Joint Program Office (JPO), Imagery/Measurement and Signature Intelligence Collection Manager for the United States Central Command's Joint Intelligence Center Central, Program Manager of ONI's JDISS JPO, the Commanding Officer of ONI's Hopper Information Services Center, and, prior to retiring in 2014, Navy's Deputy Director of Assured Command and Control on the OPNAV staff.

Mr. Page earned a bachelor's degree in Physics from UVA in 1988 and a master's degree (with honors) in ITM from the Naval Postgraduate School in 1996. He is the recipient Armed Forces Communications and Electronics Association's Award for Meritorious Service to the Intelligence Community, Rear Admiral Grace Murray Hopper Award for Academic and Leadership Excellence in the Field of ITM, Legion of Merit, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Joint Services Commendation Medal, Naval and Marine Corps
