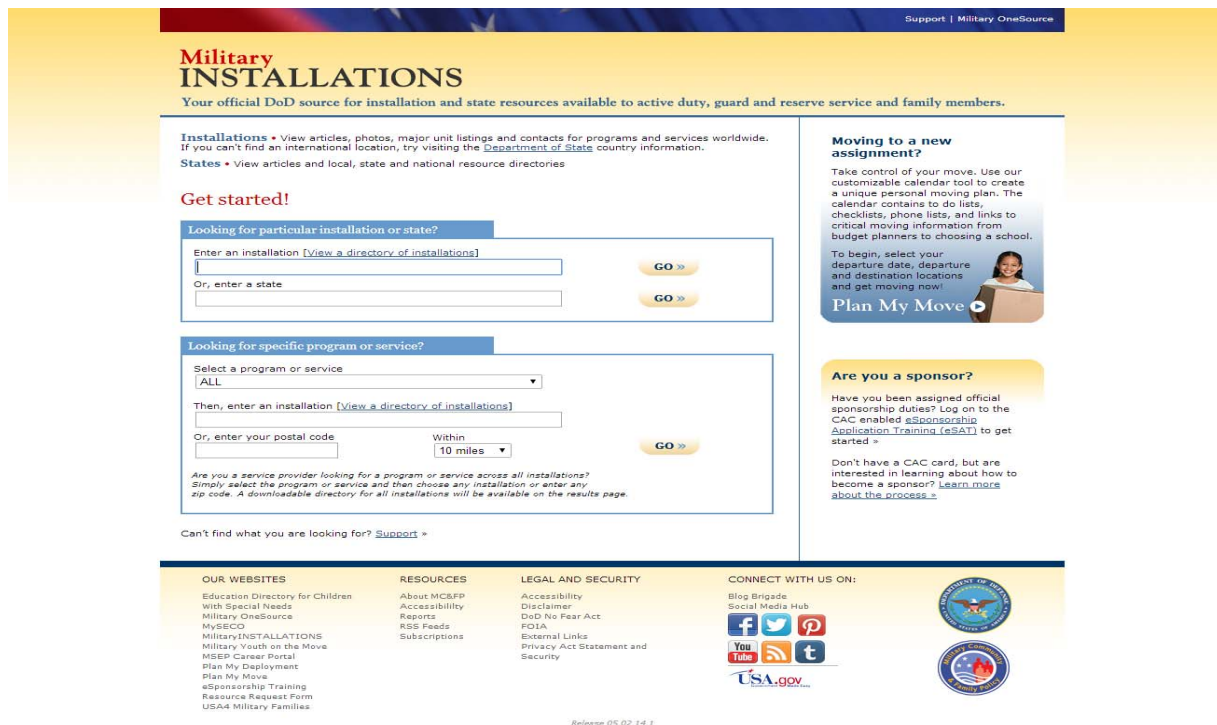

# Installations, in-depth

The Fast Facts page is a perfect launching point to get to know the installation. First, look to the left column (A) of the website, where you'll find the main contact information for the installation including a link to view a map of the area. Under that, you'll find a list of links offering information on everything from child care to deployment support.

Click the blue tabs (B) across the top of the content to quickly access an in-depth overview of the installation, contacts for all programs and services offered on the installation, a photo gallery and a comprehensive listing of major units. The next tab, called **Installation Booklet**, will be an invaluable resource whether you are preparing to relocate or just looking for a quick reference to keep by your phone. You can even customize it to meet the needs of you and your family! The final tab takes you to **Military OneSource** where you'll find helpful resources for your life outside the gate.

The column on the right (C) also offers loads of information, such as local weather, quick access to your relocation manager and an extensive list of additional resources. Just click the + symbol next to a topic to view helpful links to official resources. You can also access **Plan My Move**, a customizable calendar tool, from this column.

JFSAP has been available in all states and territories since September 2008.

JFSAP teams are comprised of one Military and Family Life Counselor (MFLC), one Child and Youth Behavioral Counselor (CYB-MFLC), one Military OneSource (MOS) Consultant, and one additional position (state choice of a MOS Consultant, MFLC, CYB-MFLC, or Personal Financial Counselor (PFC)) based on the need of each state.

JFSAP teams serve members and families from all Services and collaborate with existing family support resources to augment their activities and fill gaps where they exist. JFSAP teams provide the following services and resources:

- information and referrals to community services and support
- non-medical counseling and education to individuals, families, and groups
- child and youth services, including assistance locating child care
- financial education and counseling
- on-demand support for Yellow Ribbon Reintegration Program (YRRP) and other deployment events
- deliver assistance in local communities through collaborative partnerships with federal and non-federal entities, to enhance a community's capacity to serve military families.

**Defense Service Network (DSN) Dialing Instructions:** The DSN is the provider of long-distance communications service for the Department of Defense (DoD). Every installation has a special DSN number and the numbers vary by world-wide location. In order to place a call using DSN, the caller must be using a military phone on an installation. Cell phones cannot dial DSN numbers. When dialing a DSN number from a United States installation to another United States installation, it is unnecessary to dial the DSN 312 area code. When dialing a DSN number to/from overseas locations, the DSN area code must be included. The operator can be reached at commercial (719) 567-1110. Please note that long distance charges may be incurred.
