FASTDATA implemented the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) requirements for the SF182 training document.

Defense Finance and Accounting Service requires a Social security number (SSN) for Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Payments on SF1164 vouchers.

PII collected includes: Name, Social Security Number (SSN), truncated SSN, mailing/home address, date of birth (DOB), home phone number, disability information: special needs, office e-mail office mailing address, office telephone number, position, payment, expenditure and course training information: SF182 - Authorization, Agreement and certification of Training: Name, SSN, DOB, Home Address, Home Telephone, Office telephone, Office email, Title, and Disability Information, SF1164 - Claim for Reimburse for Expenditures on Official Business: Name, SSN, Home Address, and Office telephone. (See Section 3a).

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

The PII data in FASTDATA is not transmitted to any other system. Privacy Act fields are encrypted as required for data at rest. The SSN is masked by asterisks (\*\*\*-\*\*-\*\*\*), when printed on the SF182 or SF1164. Printed SF182s are sent to the Command human resources offices by digitally signed e-mail's(not part of the application functionality), hardcopy, or fax. SF1164s are sent to DFAS by fax, as they will not accept them by any other method.

Commands mitigate use of PII with Command credit card rather than individual credit cards for charges to cover various training or conference scenarios. Documents created outside of FASTDATA are handled by physical controls.
