- g. Summary of DoD information system or electronic collection. Answers to these questions should be consistent with security guidelines for release of information to the public.
  - (1) Describe the purpose of this DoD information system or electronic collection and briefly describe the types of personal information about individuals collected in the system.

Trident Refit Facility Information System (TRFIS) is used to collect and process command manpower data and specifically supports data collection requirements in support of feeding the Civilian Resource Management Module (CRMM) within Trident Logistics Data System (TLDS) for payroll processing and security clearance verification. Historical information obtained from certified data is loaded each pay period into CRMM (TLDS). The DoD ID number and individual's name are used for system access. The TRFIS architecture is undergoing enhancements that will eventually eliminate the use of social security numbers in the TRFIS by isolating SSN tables off-line and only using the DoD ID number for internal TRFIS use.

Personal information currently collected includes: Name, SSN (full and truncated), and security clearance.

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

Privacy risks to the individual associated with the collected PII are unauthorized access to the data or possible misuse of the data. System access controls are in place to safeguard PII and restrict access to individuals with a job related requirement to access the data. These access controls strictly limit access to the application and/or specific functional areas of the application. The controls consist of privileges, general access, and discretionary access control. Additionally, each user is associated with one or more roles. Each role provides some combination of privileges to a subset of the database contents. Users are granted only those privileges that are necessary for their job requirements. These controls are reinforced through training of users on the authorized use and proper handling of the PII data.
