CERTIFICATE OF APPORTIONMENT OF \$346,517,212 OF THE APPROPRIATION FOR DINGELL-JOHNSON SPORT FISH RESTORATION TO THE STATES, THE COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO RICO, GUAM, THE U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS, AMERICAN SAMOA, THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS, AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015

Pursuant to the Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Restoration Act, as amended (16 U.S.C. 777 et seq.), we have, at this time, apportioned \$346,517,212 to the States, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and the District of Columbia. The funds so apportioned are based on the amount credited during Fiscal Year 2014 to the Sport Fish Restoration Account. This includes \$23,835,199 that was sequestered in 2014 and is now available. A preliminary apportionment of \$233,404,626 was made on November 23, 2014, and is included as part of this final apportionment. The funds are available for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2014, and are available for the period of time specified in the Act.

The amounts apportioned to the States are as provided by Section 4 of the Act, and adjusted so no State shall receive more than 5 percent or less than 1 percent of the total amount apportioned.

The amounts apportioned to the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and the District of Columbia are as provided by Section 12 of the Act.

Therefore, in accordance with the above, the apportionment of Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Restoration funds for Fiscal Year 2015 is as shown on the enclosed tabulation.
