The Office of Nuclear Physics is always in the need for scientists to work temporarily for periods lasting six months to a few years on detailee and Intergovernmental Personnel Act assignments. There are opportunities within both Divisions in the Office. The benefits are not just to our Office, but also to the scientists coming into our Office to work. They gain a federal perspective of the nuclear science program which cannot be gained any other way and which is extremely beneficial to their career development. The Office is interested in a variety of skill types and levels of experience.

Currently we are seeking individuals that would be interested in assisting the Office in the areas of Heavy Ion Physics, Fundamental Symmetries, and Nuclear Structure and Astrophysics.
