New Proposals Seeking FY2017 Funding for Research

As part of its continuing effort to ensure a U.S. nuclear science research program of the highest quality and impact, the Physics Research Division of the DOE Office of Nuclear Physics (NP) is implementing a deadline of September 30, 2016 for all new proposals seeking FY2017 funding for research. New proposals are applications for funding to create a new research grant, or an existing award that proposes new scope of work. A new co-PI faculty staff joining an existing NP supported group will also be required to submit a new proposal for consideration. Proposals for renewal of an existing award which do not involve new scope of work will be processed and peer reviewed normally according to their project expiration dates.
