Details of Substantive Changes and Instructions to the COs

 New solicitations, and awards issued after the effective date of this transmittal shall include new and revised clauses incorporated into this BPI Update.
 New orders and blacket numbers agreements issued against Federal Supply Schedules shall conform to the

New orders and blanket purchase agreements issued against Federal Supply Schedules shall conform to the newly published Part 29 as of the effective date of this transmittal.

- <u>Required Sources:</u> BPI section 6.8 has been revised to clarify the required sources of supply which shall be considered before using commercial sources. BPA shall use excess inventory and personal property prior to submitting requests for new supplies or products. Federal Prison Industries products and supplies, as well as AbilityOne products and services must be considered prior to using other sources. Requisitioners shall consider these sources in their market research before commercial sources.
- 3. <u>Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act:</u> Policy has introduced new procurement requirements to comply with accessibility standards. From the effective date of this transmittal, all new procurements of electronic and information technology will require evidence that the supply and/or service meets the applicable standards or is exempt from the standards. Requisitioners and contracting officers shall ensure all requirements documents require contractor compliance of Section 508.
- 4. **Printing**: Clause 6-2 usage prescription has been revised to mandate use in all solicitations and contracts. This clause has been incorporated in Clause 28-20 for commercial contracts.
- 5. <u>Equal Opportunity</u>: Revised equal opportunity language to implement Executive Order 13672 which added sexual orientation and gender identity to the prohibited basis of discrimination established by EO 11246.
- 6. <u>Leasing of Motor Vehicles</u>: This update introduces new procurement policy requirements regarding the leasing (renting) of motor vehicles. As of the effective date of this transmittal, any leasing of motor vehicle will follow the requirements in subpart 6.11.
- 7. <u>Solicitation policies:</u> Subpart 11.1 has been revised to clarify the priority of mandatory sources for BPA supplies and services. For supplies, consideration shall be made as follows: (1) excess property/inventory, (2) Federal Prison Industries, (3) AbilityOne and then (4) commercial sources. For services, consideration shall be made to AbilityOne and vending facilities to Randolph-Sheppard Act programs before commercial sources. Contracting officers shall document the official file that these sources were considered, as well as the rationale for opting for a commercial source, for all solicitations and awards.
- 8. <u>Part 29 Federal Supply Schedules:</u> Part 29 has been incorporated to provide policy regarding usage of federal supply schedules. Use of federal supply schedules is not mandatory; however, if a CO elects to utilize federal supply schedules the policy and procedures of this part shall be followed.
- 9. This update corrects errors and omissions in Part 35 which were made under BPI Update 16-1. Re-inserts clauses 28-8 and 28.10.2. No changes to these clauses have been made.
