Prof. Johansen received her Ph.D. in Atmospheric Chemistry from Caltech in 1999 and is currently a professor in Chemistry at Central Washington University in nearby Ellensburg, WA, about 100 miles northeast of EMSL. She has extensive experience in the collection and analysis of atmospheric aerosol particles and is actively involved in field and laboratory work. Her current and past funding has come from NSF, NIH, NPS, and the Department of Ecology with primary emphasis on the chemical characterization of aerosol particles in the context of global climate and human health. Some of the analyses were carried out at EMSL through the user proposal process.

Dr. Johansen has served as an EMSL Peer Reviewer since 2006, a member of the Proposal Review Panels since 2013, and has been a member of the User Executive Committee since 2009. Her cross-disciplinary research interests and experience, combined with her position at a regional comprehensive university such as CWU, places her in a unique position to ensure that user interests within the area of atmospheric chemistry are well represented.
