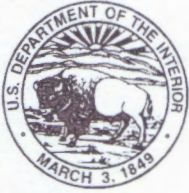

We hereby issue this Notification of Incidents of Noncompliance (INC) to Alliance Oilfield Services for the following violation of the regulation as stipulated below:
