17. DESCRIBE IN SEQUENCE HOW ACCIDENT HAPPENED:

While conducting crew change operations by boat, the arriving crane operator went to relieve the crane operator scheduled to go home. After the releiving operator took over crane operations, the departing operator walked from the cab of the crane to the rear of the crane to a set of fixed stairs utilized to access the crane from the deck. During this time, the crane was not shut down, it was pivoting on the pedastal. The operator departing the platform was pinned between the handrail on the back of the crane and the handrail post of the fixed stairway. The departing operator sustained a compound fracture of the right ankle, a fractured right tibia, six fractured ribs and a collapsed lung. He was medi-vac'd to Terrebonne General Medical Center in Houma, LA for examination and treatment.

18. LIST THE PROBABLE CAUSE(S) OF ACCIDENT:

During crew change operations, the crane operator coming on tour did not wait for the crane operator that was getting off tour to clear crane walk around before he resumed crane activities. Also the injured person tried to disembark the crane walk around while the crane was in motion.

19. LIST THE CONTRIBUTING CAUSE(S) OF ACCIDENT:

Crane operators need to totally shut down crane activities to allow personnel time to disembark. They should visually check that everyone is clear before crane activities resume.

20. LIST THE ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Hercules Offshore has added Corrective Action C-0904-0020 to their HSE Policy and Operations Manual / Best Practices. This will be in HSE 100.21 sub section 4.2 and include the following: Crane Operators must always be contacted before anyone approaches stair access to the crane; personnel must wait until crane movement has stopped before climbing up to the crane; and the crane operator will treat the ingress and egress as a helicoper approach with the exception of cradling the boom to verify personel are clear.
