#### 17. DESCRIBE IN SEQUENCE HOW ACCIDENT HAPPENED:

On October 23, 2007, at approximately 7:00, at Chevron U.S.A. Inc.'s OCS-G 05753, Mobile (MO) 916 A Platform, an employee was injured when he smashed his own index finger on his left hand with a hammer and a hammer wrench, as a result of human error. Injured Person (IP) received stitches, no break or fracture. IP was placed on light duty.

#### Sequence of Events:

Employee was tightening up a flange and smashed his own left index finger with a hammer and hammer wrench. IP was sent in to seek medical attention. The Safety Supervisor with Quality Energy Services reported that the IP did not have a break or a fracture, however did receive stitches to the open cut on his finger. IP has been on light duty since the accident and is expected to be fully released once he has his follow up visit this week.
