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17. DESCRIBE IN SEQUENCE HOW ACCIDENT HAPPENED:

The Bois D'Arc field boat, the M/V Angelle Cenac, departed the field at 1930 hours on January 18, 2005, to return to the Dulac Dock. The vessel passed by Ship Shoal 92 platform 3 and noticed that the navigation light was working. The next morning, at 0900 hours, on the trip back to the field, the captain of the motor vessel noticed an outrigger lying across the platform. Due to damage the platform, the fog horn and navigation lights could not be checked immediately. They were checked at dark on January 19, 2005 by Bois D'Arc personnel and found to be working properly.

An unknown commercial shrimping vessel struck the platform in the middle of the night, leaving part of the outrigger on the platform, causing damage to the structure.
