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17. INVESTIGATION FINDINGS: -

At 13:50 a Galley Hand spotted a fire and sounded the alarm. The fire was coming from a cardboard box containing an electric motor on the production deck below the barbecue and smoking area, which is also a muster location. The crew mustered and suited up for response. At 13:51 the fire was extinguished with a 30 lb handheld ABC fire extinguisher. The fire started to flare again and was extinguished with a fire hose. At 13:55 the platform was inspected for possible fire damage. Notification process was started at 14:15. The fire was likely caused by a cigarette or charcoal ember falling into the box.

18. LIST THE PROBABLE CAUSE(S) OF ACCIDENT:

Ignition was caused by a cigarette or charcoal ember.

19. LIST THE CONTRIBUTING CAUSE(S) OF ACCIDENT:

The box was placed in a location were it could come into contact with an ignition source.

Wind speed was between 20 and 25 knots, any embers which would have fallen directly into the water were blown back towards the platform. No physical barriers to prevent ember movement.

20. LIST THE ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Fire was not within 35 feet of hydrocarbon processing equipment or piping. Anadarko has installed solid plating beneath its cigarette cans at the Gunnison facility and issued a safety alert.
