g. Summary of DoD information system or electronic collection. Answers to these questishould be consistent with security guidelines for release of information to the public.  (1) Describe the purpose of this DoD information system or electronic collection and briefly describe the types of personal information about individuals collected in the system.  ScriptPro SP Central System with Telepharmacy Remote Dispensing and Verification System (TRDVS) is Automated Information System (AIS). The main purpose of the system is to automate the filling of prescriptions and to serve as a workflow management tool within the pharmacy to provide accurate, verificand efficient drug dispense by use of state of the art robotic technology. SP Central works with the existin pharmacy computer system and utilizes barcode scanning controls to ensure prescription accuracy. This advanced workflow technology directs the dispensing process from point of entry to patient delivery.  ScriptPro Health Messaging Services (HMS) is a browser-based messaging system that support the TRD program by allowing pharmacy staff and health care providers to generate or review messages from any internet-connected computer and connect to the SP Central-HMS hosted environment in a Navy data cent HMS integrates with SP Central allowing users on the HMS system to send messages directly to pharmacy in the enterprise or pharmacy staff to send messages to HMS from their SP Central workstations.  The types of PII collected in the system include name, birth date, prefix (an assigned number), gender of patient, prescription number, and SSN of sponsor.  (2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.  All systems are vulnerable to "insider threats." Pharmacy managers are vigilant to this threat by limiting system access to those individuals who have a defined need to access the information. There are defined criteria to Identwho should have access to ScriptPro SP Central - HMS. These in
