Navy Readiness Reporting Enterprise - (NRRE)

The NRRE is a federation of Navy-owned information systems that is comprised of:

- Defense Readiness Reporting System Navy (DRRS-N)
- Navy Global Force Management Organization Server (GFM NOS)
- Global Force Management Enterprise Translation Service (GFM ETS)
- Navy Training Information Management System (NTIMS)
- Navy Reserve Readiness Module (NRRM)

The Navy Readiness Reporting Enterprise (NRRE) systems collect data from authoritative data sources and produces information to support unit readiness reporting requirements for Congress, OSD, the Joint Staff, and Combatant Commanders and Navy leadership. This data includes human resource qualifications and skills; individual personnel readiness data, equipment status, training status, ordnance availability and information about supplies. Ultimately, the information collected is used in algorithms that produce scores that reflect the status of resources used by the unit to conduct operational missions.

Access to the Navy Readiness Reporting Enterprise (NRRE) systems is limited to authorized and appropriately cleared personnel as determined by the system manager. All Navy Readiness Reporting Enterprise (NRRE) information/records are maintained in controlled facilities. Physical entry is restricted by use of locks, guards, and is accessible only to authorized, cleared personnel. Access to information/records is limited to person(s) responsible for servicing/analyzing the record in the performance of official duties, who are properly screened and possess a "need to know." Access to computerized data is restricted by passwords, which are required to be changed in accordance with current directives. NRRE applications are stored on the Navy's NIPR and SIPR systems.

Global Force Management Enterprise Translation Service (GFM ETS)

GFM ETS supports the transformational efforts of the GFM Data Initiative (GFM DI) Next Steps for Manpower and Personnel. It provides the Navy's capability to publish face-to-space associations, using the GFM Navy Org Server (NOS) authorized force structure information, N1 personnel assignment and distribution information, DMDC personal identifiers and a translation algorithm converting legacy identifiers to the new enterprise DoD-wide identifiers. The GFM ETS application exists in both the NIPRNET and the SIPRNET (future capability) domains, and it publishes information using a net centric messaging service.

The GFM ETS protects personally identifiable information (PII) by complying with SECNAVINST 5211.5E and various other Department of the Navy (DON) policy messages and memorandum. Only individuals certified as having a "position of trust" are allowed access and handling of GFM ETS PII data. All transmission of PII information is protected by an encrypted transmission method. The two methods used are SSL and VPN. The storage of PII data is protected by 'salting' data values, and applying a cryptographic FIPS 140-2 compliant hash algorithm with FIPS 140-2 cell level encryption and full database encryption.

Navy Reserve Readiness Module (NRRM)

The Navy Reserve Readiness Module (NRRM) is the Navy's authoritative data source for Navy Reserve readiness information. It is a web-based program that uses a two-tier architecture consisting of: a) a web application; and b) database servers that provide the user with a clear picture of current readiness.

This application is included in the NRRE PIA to accurately reflect its association in Navy Readiness Reporting.

PII includes: Name, full and truncated SSN, gender, race/ethnicity, birth date, home telephone number, mailing/home address, security clearance, marital status, child information, medical information, military records, rank/rate.

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

The perceived threats are primarily computer hackers, disgruntled employees, information warfare initiated by foreign activies, and acts of nature (e.g., fire, flood, etc.).

All systems are at risk because they may be vulnerable to unauthorized intrusion and hacking. These are risks, and the NRRE, with its collection of PII, could be comprised. Because of this possibility, appropriate security and access controls listed in this PIA are in place.

All systems are vulnerable to "insider threats." NRRE System Managers are aware of this threat, and the risk is mitigated by_limiting system access to those individuals who have a defined need to access this information. There are prodedures to properly screen who should have access to the NRRE. These individuals have gone through extensive background and employment checks.
