This system provides pop-up messages to NMCI workstations attached to the Local Area Network. system is locally known as AtHoc (AtHoc is the name of the system given by the vendorit is not an acronymn). It also has the capability to notify members in the database, through electronic mail and	
telephone, of personnel recalls, real world and exercise threat conditions. This system is in the initial cycle phase, and system owner is the USMC.	

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

The PII Name items are: home phone, cell phone, work phone, employee type, unit name, home electronic mail address, and work electronic mail address. All reports generated from the Telecommunications Notifications System containing Personally Identifiable Information (PII) will be used for the sole purpose of validating confirmation alert messages. These reports will only be reviewed by Command Post personnel and applicable leadership authorities and then will be shredded upon completion of need. Access to the Base Local Area Network containing the PII data is limited to Common Access Card users and further restricts Telecommunications Notifications System users as designated by the USMC who are further restricted by the Telecommunications Notifications System application access with an additional user identification and password.
