U.S. diesel fuel price continues to increase

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose to \$2.94 a gallon on Monday. That's up 8-tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest at 3.33 a gallon in the New England and Central Atlantic regions. Prices were lowest at 2.80 a gallon in the Gulf Coast region and in the Rocky Mountain states.
