

U.S. diesel fuel prices decrease from previous week

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$2.87 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.4 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the Mid-Atlantic states at 3.12 a gallon, down half a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Midwest states at 2.75 a gallon, down 2 cents from a week ago.
