

U.S. diesel fuel prices continue to increase

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel increased to \$2.41 a gallon on Monday. That's up 3.9 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.66 a gallon, up 3 and a half cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.27 a gallon, up 2 cents.
