U.S. diesel fuel prices increase

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel increased to \$2.39 a gallon on Monday. That's up 7-tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.66 a gallon, up 1.8 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.25 a gallon, up 2 cents.
