Diesel prices decrease for first time in four weeks

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell for the first time in 4 weeks to \$3.89 a gallon on Monday. That's down 2.4 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 4.11 a gallon, down 8-tenths of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 3.78 a gallon, down 2.2 cents.
