U.S. diesel prices continue to increase

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel rose to \$3.92 a gallon on Monday. That's up a tenth of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 4.11 a gallon, up half a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.82 a gallon, up 3-tenths of a penny. This is Amerine Woodyard, with EIA, in Washington.
