U.S. gasoline price increases for the first time since September (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose for the first time since September to \$2.07 a gallon on Monday. That's up 2.4 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
