U.S. gasoline prices continue to decrease (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$1.76 a gallon on Monday. That's down 6.3 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.31 a gallon, down 6.3 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Midwest states at 1.52 a gallon, down 10.4 cents.
