U.S. gasoline price decrease for first time in seven weeks (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$2.45 a gallon on Monday. That's down 3.4 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
