U.S. gasoline prices remain steady (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline remained unchanged this week at \$2.78 a gallon on Monday, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.38 a gallon, down 6.7 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.54 a gallon, up 5.3 cents.
