U.S. gasoline prices increase from previous week (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$2.84 a gallon on Monday. That's up 5.5 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.33 a gallon, down 4.3 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.59 a gallon, up 5.7 cents.
